How to upload your electronic thesis to Pure

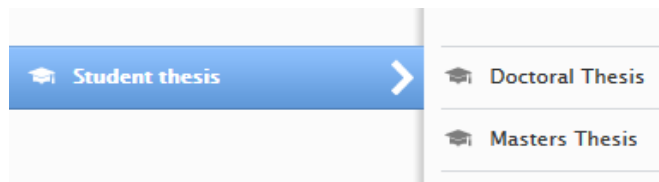
1. Log in to Pure: Go to

<https://purehost.bath.ac.uk/admin/> and log in with your University of Bath username and password.

2. Create a thesis record: Click on the green *Add new* button in the top right hand corner of the screen.



This will open a *Choose submission* window. In the left hand menu, click on *Student thesis* and then select either the *Doctoral* or *Masters Thesis*. Then select the relevant degree template.



Please read the deposit licence. If you do not agree to it or have any concerns about the public availability of your thesis, contact openaccess@bath.ac.uk.

Once you have agreed to the license, a blank record will open.

3. Fill in the details of your thesis in the following sections:

Qualification

- check it is correct

Publication information

- language
- the title (and subtitle) of your thesis
- the abstract or summary

Authors, organisations, and placement

- check your name displays correctly
- if your department has not come through automatically, add it as an organisation and to the 'Student thesis managed by' section

Thesis information

- Date of award – don't worry if you don't know the exact date, just add the year and we will update with the correct information

- Awarding Institution – click *Add organisation* and use the *search for organisation (internal)* tab to search for and select University of Bath

Supervisor(s)

- check details are correct and add any missing names

Keywords (optional)

- one word or phrase per box

4. Upload your full thesis: You need to upload your thesis as a single pdf file. If you have your thesis as a single word processing file, please upload that too.

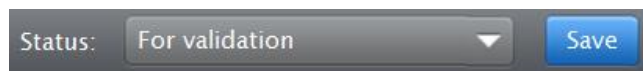

Click on *Add document...* Use the *Browse* option to locate the file you need, set *Visibility* to *Backend* and then click *Create*.

5. Save the record: Click the blue *Save* button at the bottom of the record, leaving the status as *For validation*.



6. Note the Pure record ID: Re-open the record by clicking on its title. Make a note of the *Id* number in the top left hand corner of the record. You must write this *Id* number on your *University of Bath Higher Degree Electronic Thesis Submission Form* (overleaf).

7. Congratulations! You have now uploaded your



thesis to Pure. Be sure to complete the *University of Bath Higher Degree Electronic Thesis Submission Form* (overleaf) and hand it in with your hard copy. Your thesis will not be publicly available online until after you graduate.
